Aim of Course:

To further build on core skills and knowledge of health and social care staff working with people affected by stroke.

Outcomes:

By the end of the course participants will have:

- examined and reflected on their knowledge and skills about stroke
- increased their core knowledge and skills about stroke from the Introductory Course (Part 1) if applicable
- identified areas where further learning is required
- identified areas in their own clinical practice where improvements/changes would be beneficial.
