

## **Glasgow Stroke MCN Nursing Education Bursaries 2008-09**

1. Payment for a course/module/programme will be made direct to the higher education institution and not to the individual.
2. Successful applicants must submit an invoice on headed notepaper directed to Professor Lorraine N Smith, University of Glasgow with the exact amount required and identifying the course/module or programme and the higher education institution.
3. The bursary will be awarded once the successful applicant demonstrates that they have been awarded a place on their designated course.
4. The bursary is for the cost of the course/module or tuition fee only.
5. Applicants must be employed in what was the Greater Glasgow Health Board and must supply a letter of support from their employer on headed notepaper via email or post.
6. You should have a minimum of 2 years experience working in the Greater Glasgow area.
7. Applications should be submitted by email to: [l.n.smith@clinmed.gla.ac.uk](mailto:l.n.smith@clinmed.gla.ac.uk)
8. The application must be completed in full and be only 1 page.
9. You may submit via email, a CV with your application.
10. All applicants will be notified by email regarding the outcome of their application.
11. You may apply for an individual courses or for an entire programme e.g. MScHC.
12. It is expected that the courses or programme undertaken will be accredited by a higher education institution.
13. The courses or programme must inform your stroke nursing practice and you must demonstrate how this is to be done in your application.
14. The decision regarding the bursary is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
15. If a successful applicant fails to complete the course/module/programme undertaken, that individual will be required to return the award in full with a cheque made payable to the University of Glasgow and sent to Professor Lorraine N Smith, Nursing & Health Care, 59 Oakfield Avenue, Glasgow G12 8LW. The employer and Stroke MCN will be informed.
