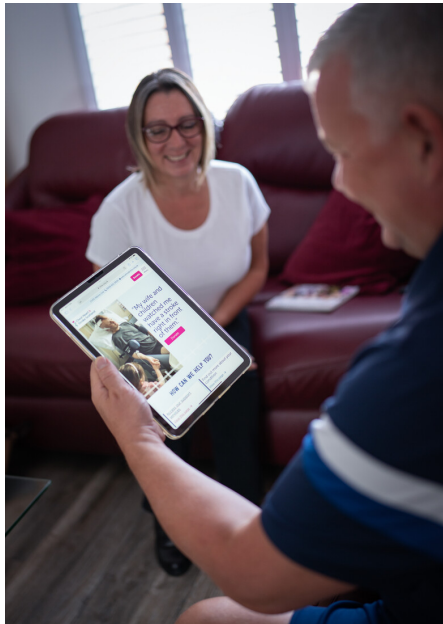




# **6 Month Post Stroke Review**

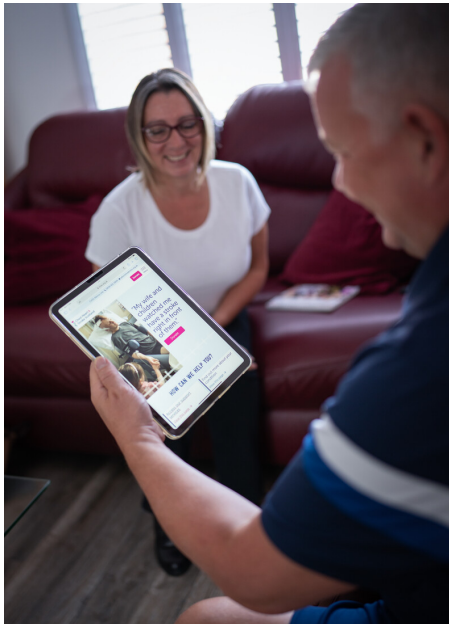
## What is this?



A review of how you are after your stroke.

- Reflect on what you have achieved.
- Highlight any needs that have not been addressed.

## How?



- 6 month review will be carried out by your CHSS Stroke Nurse or other relevant health care professional.

Discussion via phone/video call/ home visit.

- You can decide who completes this review with you.

## When?

Around 6 months from the date of your stroke.

- Review date will be set at first contact with your CHSS Stroke Nurse but can be changed nearer the time if required.
- Review will take around an hour, depending on your needs



## Why?



- Recommended by Scottish Government in the 'Progressive Stroke Pathway', March 22.
- To ensure that you 'live no life half lived' and continue to meet your personal goals.

Will facilitate access into specialist services where required.

- Ensure any unmet needs following your stroke are met.
- To give you the opportunity to ask any questions you may have on your recovery.



**NB: You do not need to have a 6 month review if you do not want one,  
just let your CHSS Stroke Nurse know.**
