



## What is this?



A review of how you are after your stroke.

- Reflect on what you have achieved.
- Highlight any needs that have not been addressed.

## How?



• 6 month review will be carried out by your CHSS Stroke Nurse or other relevant health care professional.

Discussion via phone/video call/ home visit.

You can decide who completes this review with you.

## When?

Around 6 months from the date of your stroke.

 Review date will be set at first contact with your CHSS Stroke Nurse but can be changed nearer the time if required.



 Review will take around an hour, depending on your needs

## Why?



- Recommended by Scottish Government in the 'Progressive Stroke Pathway', March 22.
- To ensure that you 'live no life half lived' and continue to meet your personal goals.

Will facilitate access into specialist services where required.

- Ensure any unmet needs following your stroke are met.
- To give you the opportunity to ask any questions you may have on your recovery.

NB: You do not need to have a 6 month review if you do not want one, just let your CHSS Stroke Nurse know.
